## Espasso to debut new Arthur Casas furniture collection

Espasso, the New York City showroom known for modern and contemporary Brazilian furniture, art and design objects, is debuting "Made in America," a new exhibition by Brazilian architect-designer Arthur Casas that includes pieces he handcrafted in Brooklyn shown alongside his work from Brazil.
