## ESPASSO

Carlos Junqueira's eclectic Brazilian furniture stash comes to the

vintage-clogged neighborhood of Tribeca (neighbors include R 20th Century, Urban Archaeology, and John Kelly). The late-industrial space is tricked out with a grand staircase that doubles

as a display area.

In addition to the mid-century vintage from Lucio Costa and Sergio Rodrigues, there are re-editions from Branco & Preto, and contemporary designs from Claudia Moreira Salles. 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## KORRES
