Jorge Zalszupin designed the 801 sofa in the early 1960s for his seminal Brazilian mid-century design firm L'Atelier. Its delicate, tapered wooden feet, straightforward frame and slight angled arms have been rediscovered and reissued as a long-lost Brazilian mid-century treasure.
