Originally designed in the 1960s, this armchair is named after Jorge Zalszupin's wife, Anette. Only a few prototypes were made at the time until finally being re-edited in 2014.

- Base structure made of black iron and belt leather straps
- Belt leather available in six different options
- Upholstery offered in a variety of fabrics, leather, COM/COL
- Arm rest made of a variety of woods
- Optional matching ottoman
